*Online Cognitive Behavioral Therapy for Depressive Symptoms in Rural Patients with Coronary Heart Disease*

Using a randomized, controlled, stratified (by sex) design, we will compare real-time, face-to-face interaction with a therapist—video-conferenced CBT (vcCBT) and internet-based self-administered CBT without a face-to-face therapist (iCBT) in rural CHD patients on the primary outcome of depressive symptoms over time.
