

**Summary of changes to Academic Leadership Positions and Administrative Bylaws**  
(highlighted as blue text in attached documents)

**1. Changes to Academic Leadership Position Titles and Descriptions**

The Provost directed the College of Nursing to reduce the amount of faculty DOE time assigned to Administration beginning in the 2020-2021 fiscal year. The following changes were made in Titles and respective Academic Leadership Position Descriptions in response to the directive.

- Information and Instructional Technology Advisory Council (ITT) was replaced with the new Instructional Design and Innovation Council (IDI)

Administrative Council additions: Two new councils were created to promote BSN practice readiness and student success

- Council for BSN Practice Readiness
- Council for BSN Student Success

New positions added

- Chair of Practice Readiness (15% DOE under Service)
- Chair of Student Success (15% DOE under Service)
