### **Government Committee Work and Legislative Testimony**

*Nov. 2012 – Dec. 2015: Kentucky Board of Nursing Controlled Substances Formulary Committee, Governor-appointed*

Committee was tasked with developing and maintaining the approved controlled substances formulary for Advanced Practice Registered Nurses in the State of Kentucky. During my tenure changes to decrease the number of restricted medications permitted under the Collaborative Advanced Practice Agreement for Controlled Substances were initiated.

*Nov. 2012 – 2018: Kentucky All Schedule Prescription Electronic Reporting (KASPER) Advisory Task Force, Governor-appointed. Task force work completed.*

The task force set standards for monitoring controlled substances prescribing habits in the state for all licensed providers (physicians, dentists, nurse practitioners, osteopaths) and set standards for pain clinics. My responsibility in representing all Advanced Practice Registered Nurses in the state was to ensure prescription monitoring requirements were equal across disciplines.

*July 12, 2013: Kentucky Licensing and Occupational Joint Committee Session*

Testimony before the Kentucky Senate L&O Committee in support of the Collaborative Agreement for the Advanced Practice Registered Nurse's Prescriptive Authority for Nonscheduled Legend Drugs (CAPA-NS) removal.

Senate committee (Joint Licensing and Occupation Committee) appointed professional and lay individuals to negotiate a compromise bill between advanced practice registered nurses and physician representatives as it applied to SB 7. Project involved preparation and conduct for negotiating sessions with physicians and senate representatives during four scheduled meetings scheduled over a six-month period.

Committee tasked by statute to assist Advanced Practice Registered Nurses establishing collaborative practice agreements with physicians.

*March 2015: Kentucky LEADS Collaborative (Lung Cancer Education, Awareness, Detection, Survivorship)*

Sponsored by the University of Louisville, this multidisciplinary collaborative group was tasked to develop education standards and programs to screen for lung cancer for the State of Kentucky. The outcome was a continuing educational program for all healthcare providers. Further, a public awareness program and anti-smoking initiative was created.
