## Deans' Interprofessional Honors Colloquium (DIHC)

The IP course will provide students with an interactive seminar-based forum to explore the characteristics and implications of IP practice. Methods of instruction will include seminars with a variety of IP guest speakers, and significant interactive small group learning. Students will be in a group of about 8 to 10 students including students from various healthcare colleges and other disciplines. IP small groups will complete a project to be presented to the DIHC facilitators, leaders within the healthcare colleges, and invited guests.

DIHC is a 1 credit interprofessional cognate course. The course (NUR 390) is offered in the Fall and Spring semester. It meets 5 times on Friday afternoons starting at 2 pm. The specific dates will be available mid-semester the semester prior to the start of the course.
